## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** OREGON STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH & WILDLIFE

of 506 S.W. Mill St., Portland, State of Oregon, 97201, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Fall River

a tributary of Deschutes River for the purpose of fish propagation and maintenance of ponds and domestic use for three houses

under Permit No. 9212 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 21, 1929

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.0 cubic feet per second, being 2.97 c.f.s. for fish propagation and maintenance of ponds and 0.03 c.f.s. for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 31, T. 20 S., R. 10 E., W. M., 306 feet South from the Center, Section 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 20, 1968 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 9785, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.61C.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
