CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BOHEMIA INC.

of P.O. Box 1819, Eugene, State of Oregon, 97401, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director of a right to the use of the waters of Row River

a tributary of Coast Fork Willamette River for the purpose of log deck sprinkling

under Permit No. 14106 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 2, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.3 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 30, T. 21 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 30 feet South and 30 feet West from the SW Corner of Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 30

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 23, 1976 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on page 14006, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
