a tributary of Nehalem River for the purpose of domestic use for one family, the irrigation of 0.4 acre and operation of a dairy

and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in under Permit No. 7951 accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.135 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE'4 NW4, Section 33, T. 3 N., R. 9 W., W. M., 1130 feet South and 980 feet West from the N2 Corner, Section 33

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right

is appurtenant, is as follows:
