CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

MAMIE PHILLIPS

of Rt. 4, Box 216, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, 97123, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed creek and an unnamed spring

a tributary of McFee Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 0.5 acre and domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in area under Permit No. 37204 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 30, 1973 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed creek for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. from unnamed spring for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W. M., creek-1170 feet North and 170 feet East; Spring-580 feet North and 250 feet West, both from the S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 13

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic & 0.4 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
0.1 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 13
T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
