CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROSEBURG LUMBER COMPANY

of P. O. Box 1088; Roseburg, State of Oregon, 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Cow Creek and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5448

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of industrial and fire protection

under Permit No. 34222 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 11, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.93 cubic foot per second, being 0.70 c.f.s. for industrial and 0.23 c.f.s. for fire protection and shall be limited to the period from October 1 to April 1 of each year

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4, as projected within Catching DLC 43, Section 26, T. 30 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 5710 feet South and 20 feet East from the NW Corner, Flint DLC 45

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
