under Permit No. G-3261 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 15, 1966 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.11 cubic feet per second and shall be further limited to 60,000 gallons of water per day

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, T. 40 S., R. 15 E., W. M., North 57 degrees 10 minutes West 1060.31 feet from the E $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 25

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
