EAGLE CREEK, a tributary of Powder River,

for the purpose of irrigation of 384 acres of land;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page 291 : that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1891 for 174 acres in Tract No. 1: 1879 for 210 acres in Tract No. 2;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Tract No. 1: Thirty-nine acres in Southeast quarter of Fortheast quarter: forty acres in Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Twenty-cight; thirty-nine acres in Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-one; forty acres in Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter; sixteen acres in Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-two:

Tract No. 2: thirty acres in Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter: forty acres in Southwest quarter of Northeast quarter; forty acres in Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter; twenty acres in Northwest quarter of Northwest quarter; forty acres in Southwest quarter of Northwest quarter; forty acres in Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Twenty-seven; all the above described land being in Township Nine South, Range Forty-five East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
