CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That J. W. AUER

of 13630 Simpson Rd., Monmouth, State of Oregon, 97361, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Luckiamute River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 29.5 acres

under Permit No. 19649 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 12, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.37 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Simpson DLC 69, Section 17, T. 9 S., R. 5 W., W. M., 560 feet North and 1090 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 17

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The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.6 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 16.3 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 17
 4.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
 7.6 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 20



This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 14, 1976 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 24306, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
