Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page 291;

that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1887 for 24 acres; 1906 for 6

acres: 1885 for 10 acres;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Twenty-four scres in Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter; six acres in Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter; four acres in Southeast quarter of South west quarter; four acres in Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Three; Two acres in Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Tem.
