under Permit No. 35775 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 7. 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second, being 0.50 c.f.s. for frost control and 0.33 c.f.s. for harvesting cranberries

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE4 NE4, SE4 NE4, Section 12, T. 30 S., R. 15 W., W. M., No. 1-80 feet North and 250 feet East from the SW Corner, NE4 NE4, Section 12, T. 30 S., R. 15 W., W. M.; No. 2-30 feet South and 170 feet West from the NW Corner, Section 7, T. 30 S., R. 14 W., W. M.

The amount of wat - ,ed for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
