CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That V. O. WEST

of Arlington, State of Oregon, 97812, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rock Creek

a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of irrigation of 22.1 acres

under Permit No. 40468 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 1, 1976

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.55 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T. 1 N., R. 19 E., W. M., 4820 feet South and 2170 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the period from October 1 to March 31, provided further that the right allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other existing right for the same land shall not exceed 4 acre feet for each acre irrigated in any one year. The use of water authorized here shall be subsequent in priority and inferior to any future irrigation project development for storage during the winter season and later use during the period of maximum crop demand. * and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.8 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 1.2 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 3.6 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 13.5 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$



* Sufficient flow shall be left in Rock Creek to provide stockwater through out its course during the period of use authorized herein. The use allowed herein may be made anytime between October 1 and March 31, that water can be put to beneficial use by irrigation, either for immediate crop growth or for forecast requirements to raise the soil moisture to field capacity in the soil profile to be utilized by plant growth in the subsequent growing season.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
