CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, ThatSTAYTON UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT
UH4J, C/O MERLIN MOREY, SUPT-CLERK

of 757 W. Locust St., Stayton, State of Oregon, 97383, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of North Santiam River for the purpose of irrigation of 26.0 acres

under Permit No. G-5901 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 10, 1973 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.33 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, T. 9 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 590 feet North and 680 feet East from the W $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 10

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

26.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 10
T. 9 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
