CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CARNATION COMPANY

of 3342 S.E. Morrison, Portland, State of Oregon, 97214, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two wells

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of as a condensing agent in an ammonia refrigeration system and a dairy plant wash up. under Permit No. G-6012 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 12, 1973 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.45 cubic foot per second, being 0.29 c.f.s. from Well No. 1 and 0.16 c.f.s. from Well No. 2

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Seldon Murray DLC 54, Section 1, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., W. M., Well No. 1-85 feet North and 22 feet East, Well No. 2-80 feet North and 95 feet East, both from the SW Corner, Block 17, Sunnyside Subdivision, City of Portland

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,


and shall conform to a reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
