This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 7, 1976 and together with certificate of water right recorded on Page 43988, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 16238, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
