CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JASPER LOY YOKUM

of 7719 Lower Grave Creek Rd., Wolf Creek, State of Oregon, 97497, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Butte Creek and an unnamed stream

a tributary of Grave Creek for the purpose of domestic use for two families and irrigation of 3.4 acres

under Permit No. 36644 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 14, 1972 for Butte Creek and February 17, 1972 for unnamed stream that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.05 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. from Butte Creek for domestic use, 0.02 c.f.s. from Butte Creek and 0.02 c.f.s. from unnamed stream for irrigation.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, T. 34 S., R. 7 W., W. M., No. 1-2450 feet South and 580 feet West; No. 2-900 feet South and 440 feet West, both from the N $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 10

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic & 1.0 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Domestic & 2.4 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 3
T. 34 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the duty of water to not exceed 1/80th of one cubic foot per second per acre and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water has been raised to 1/80th cubic foot per second per acre and 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, in keeping with the customary policy and determination of this office of the proper maximum limits.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
