under Permit No. 34187 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 26, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is excited and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotains, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 27 (Nz SEz SWz), Section 25, T. 6 S., R. 11 W., W. M., 30 feet South and 225 feet from the NW Corner of Lot 27 (Nz SEz SWz).

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,
