## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** OREGON STATE PARKS & RECREATION BRANCH

of 300 State Highway Bldg., Salem, State of Oregon, 97310, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Champoeg Park Well No. 3

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of general park use

under Permit No. G-6689 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 20, 1975 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.018 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within R. Newell DLC 43, Section 1, T. 4 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 765 feet North and 2430 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 1

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


