## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** CREIGHTON B. JONES

of Rt. 1, Box 81, Gervais, State of Oregon, 97026, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Jones and Finney Lake and Deep Lake

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 132.2 acres

under Permit No. 22354 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 8, 1953 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.65 cubic feet per second, being 0.73 c.f.s. from Deep Lake and 0.92 c.f.s. from Jones and Finney Lake

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Jones DLC 61, Section 12, NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within Beers DLC 38, Section 2, T. 6 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.
