## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FLOYD C. GURNEE

of Roseburg, State of Oregon, 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Deer Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 2.89 acres

under Permit No. 3838 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 1, 1918

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.036 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 20, T. 27 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


Land on which water is to be used is more explicitly described as being within Block 8, Third Brookside Addition to Roseburg, Oregon.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded on page 5018, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT superseded by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on October 30, 1968, approving transfer application No. W-134, and is issued so as to correctly describe the place of use. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
