CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That REASON D. EVENSIZER

of 15551 E. Evans Creek Rd., Rogue River, State of Oregon, 97537, has
a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of
irrigation of 4.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1893

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per
second

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 4, T. 35 S., R. 3 W., W. M.,
620 feet South and 140 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 4

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

3.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 3
1.0 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 4
T. 35 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of
diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February
4, 1976 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 16112,
Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
