CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PANTHER CREEK WATER DISTRICT

of P.O. Box 14, Otis, State of Oregon, 97368, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Panther Creek

a tributary of Salmon River for the purpose of group domestic use of 128 families

under Permit No. 29672 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 18, 1964

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34, T. 6 S., R. 10 W., W.M., 320 feet North and 520 feet East from the SW Corner, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 34

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 17, 1975 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 37300, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
