CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

MOUNTAIN FIR LUMBER COMPANY, INC.

of P.O. Box 248, Tygh Valley, State of Oregon, 97063, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Log Yard Well

a tributary of White River for the purpose of industrial use, including log deck sprinkling

under Permit No. G-6945 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 28, 1976 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.89 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 10, T. 4 S., R. 13 E., W. M., 2720 feet North and 3400 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 10

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to-----of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
