that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.51 cubic foot per second, being 0.22 c.f.s. for industrial use and 0.29 c.f.s. for sprinkling of log deck

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 16, T. 4 S., R. 13 E., W. M., 165 feet South and 275 feet West from the NE corner, Section 16

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,
