## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

WEYERHAEUSER COMPANY  
A WASHINGTON CORPORATION

of P.O. Box 9, Klamath Falls, State of Oregon, 97601, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Bear Creek, Buck Creek, Coshow Spring, Bridge Creek, West Fork Silver Creek and Guyer Creek  
a tributary of Paulina Marsh for the purpose of log road sprinkling

under Permit No. 27301 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 10, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.45 cubic foot per second, the rate of appropriation from any one source shall not exceed 0.15 c.f.s.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 36, T. 28 S., R. 11 E., W. M., Bear Creek-North 75 degrees 30 minutes West 715.83 feet from the SE Corner, Section 36; NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 14, T. 29 S., R. 12 E., W. M., Buck Creek-North 6 degrees 17 minutes East 1550.18 feet from the SW Corner, Section 14; NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 25, T. 29 S., R. 12 E., W. M.; Coshow Spring-South 48 degrees 18 minutes\*

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


