under Permit No. G-6749 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 18, 1976

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.05 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well the well is located in the SW½ SW½, as projected within Tucker DLC 52, Section 15, T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 900 feet North and 825 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 15

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
