of P. O. Box 3168, Portland, State of Oregon, 97210, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream and Bailey Reservoir constructed under Permit R-5260

a tributary of Tualatin River
irrigation of 11.2 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 40632 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 10, 1976 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 2040 feet North and 1730 feet East from the NE Corner, DeWitt DLC 57

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5260

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.



a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 58.0 acres

under Permit No. 17409 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 29, 1946 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.70 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, T. 2 S., R. 2 W., W. M., North 22 degrees East, 360 feet from the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Corner, Section 5

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
