CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

NORVILLE L. LOFTIN & ROBERT M. LOFTIN

of Rt. 1, Box 430-N, Bandon, State of Oregon, 97411, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Johnson Creek

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of supplemental frost control, irrigation and harvesting of cranberries for 5.8 acres

under Permit No. 34190 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 27, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.18 cubic foot per second, being 0.11 c.f.s. for supplemental frost control, 0.07 c.f.s. for supplemental irrigation and 0.18 c.f.s. for supplemental harvesting of cranberries

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5, T. 29 S., R. 14 W., W. M., 1452.63 feet North and 172.89 feet East from the NE one-sixteenth Corner, Section 8

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
