CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PERRY EDWARDS

of Buck Forks, State of Oregon, 97429, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director of a right to the use of the waters of North Myrtle Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of the irrigation of 9.0 acres

under Permit No. 3458 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 2, 1917 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, T. 28 S., R. 4 W., W. M. 1192 feet North and 1234 feet East from the NE Corner, Section 33

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 27

8.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 28

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 3230, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on April 26, 1979, approving transfer application No. 4150. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
