CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DENNIS CAWRSE

of Mt. Vernon, State of Oregon, 97865, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of John Day River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 252.7 acres

under Permit No. 3163 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 23, 1916 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.16 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26, T. 13 S., R. 29 E., W. M., 740 feet South and 3360 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 26

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any month prior to July 1 and shall be further limited to a total diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to about July 1 of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

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0.5 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
37.8 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
35.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
28.3 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
36.6 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.9 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.
