## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** C. G. AND LEORA M. VAN BLARICOM

of 1974 2nd Ave., Gold Hill, State of Oregon, 97525, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 0.5 acre

under Permit No. 8386 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 16, 1928

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 16, T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M., North 58 degrees West 550 feet from the SW Corner, Section 16

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 17, T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 590 feet North and 260 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 17

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 17

T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 23, 1976 and together with certificate of water right recorded on Page 43584, Volume 35 and Page 48145, Volume 41, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 39594, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
