## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in under Permit No. 40089 accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.1 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 24, T. 9 S., R. 13 E., W. M., 70 feet North and 1700 feet East from the W $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 24

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall also be limited to the water available at the point of diversion described herein, and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of the waste water

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
