CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

DALE A. NEWTON

of 1865 Reuben Boise Rd., Dallas, State of Oregon, 97338, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring, unnamed drainageway and Newton Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-6421

a tributary of Salt Creek for the purpose of domestic use for one family, fish culture and stock

under Permit No. 40309 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1975 for use from spring and June 2, 1975 for use from drainageway and* that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. from spring for domestic and 0.02 c.f.s. from drainageway and reservoir for stock and fish culture

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 14, T. 7 S., R. 6 W., W. M., Spring-1130 feet South and 190 feet West; Reservoir-150 feet South and 190 feet West, both from the Westerly NW Corner, Pankey DLC 44

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:



The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
