CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That COLTON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 53

of Box 38, Colton, State of Oregon, 97017, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Canyon Creek

a tributary of Milk Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 11.9 acres

under Permit No. 10842 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 30, 1933

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, T. 5 S., R. 3 E., W. M., 2850 feet South and 1700 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 10

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 3, T. 5 S., R. 3 E., W. M., 1000 feet South and 880 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 3

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

8.7 acres Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
3.2 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 4
T. 5 S., R. 3 E., W. M.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 11, 1966 and together with certificate of water right recorded on Page 41, Volume 48218, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 27923, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
