CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That R. H. EMMERSON & SON

of P. O. Box 130, Arcata, State of California, 95521, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Hunter Reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5065

a tributary of Little Crane Creek for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 122.0 acres

under Permit No. 32859 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 9, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 366.0 acre feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 27, T. 24 S., R. 35 E., W. M., 1050 feet South and 400 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 27

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre, a diversion of 3 acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
