CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT


This Is to Certify, That B. F. MADSENof Camp Sherman, State of Oregon, has
a right to the use of the waters of North Fork Lake Creeka tributary of Metolius River for the purpose of
irrigation of 20.8 acresand that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Deschutes County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 9, at page 362; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from June 1, 1908;that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3 acre-feet per acre,
measured at the point of diversion from the stream, which may be diverted at a
rate not to exceed 1/60th of one cubic foot per second per acre during the irri-
gation season from May 1 to September 15.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:5.5 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
15.3 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

T. 13 S., R. 9 E., W. M.This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior
certificate recorded at page 13634, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certi-
ficates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Direc-
tor entered on May 24, 1979, approving transfer application No. 4166.The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
