CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ARTHUR & SYLVIA ALTHEIDE

of 4881 Fish Hatchery Rd., Grants Pass, State of Oregon, 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Applegate River

a tributary of Rogue River
irrigation of 3.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 2805 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 13, 1915

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second, if available from the original point of diversion; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W. M., Highland Ditch-60 rods West from the SE Corner, Section 8

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 2050 feet North and 1140 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 15

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 7
T. 37 S., R. 6 W., W. M.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 17, 1976 and together with certificates of water right recorded at Page 48255, Volume 41, and Page 44003, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded at Page 4921, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
