## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** TAYLOR RANCH, INC.

of Plush, State of Oregon, 97637, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Hart Lake, natural storage

a tributary of Warner Lakes Basin for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 296.0 acres

under Permit No. 18632 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 21, 1944 for 5.40 c.f.s. April 11, 1949 for 2.00 c.f.s.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 7.4 cubic feet per second, if available at the original point of diversion; Lot 3, Section 14, T. 36 S., R. 24 E., W. M., 3050 feet South and 495 feet West from the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner, Section 14

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 14, T. 36 S., R. 24 E., W. M., 2330 feet North and 2830 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 14

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the amount of water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


