## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ROY BREWER

of Ontario , State of Oregon, 97914 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Open drainage canal of the Malheur Drainage District discharging into Snake River

a tributary of Snake River irrigation of 52.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 11152 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 9, 1933

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.65 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SE½ NW½, Section 5, T. 18 S., R. 47 E., W. M., 320 feet South and 160 feet East from the NW Corner, SE½ NW½, Section 5

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW4 NW4, Section 4, T. 18 S., R. 47 E., W. M., 341 feet South and 34 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 4

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to One-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

35.0 acres SW\ SW\ 17.0 acres SE\ SW\ Section 33 T. 17 S., R. 47 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 28, 1968 and together with certificate of water right recorded on Page 34961, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded on Page 10774, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
