## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**

MARGUERITE DECKER

of Rt. 2, Box 734, Ontario, State of Oregon, 97914, has  
a right to the use of the waters of Malheur River

a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 176.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at page 228, that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1909

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1½ acre feet per acre in any 30 day period prior to June 1st, 1 acre foot per acre in any 30 day period after June 1st, of each year, or 3 acre feet per acre during any season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-twentieth of a cubic foot per second per acre.\*

The point of diversion is located in the NE¼ NW¼, Section 32, T. 17 S., R. 47 E., W. M., 1300 feet South and 1450 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 32

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

40.0 acres SE¼ SW¼  
40.0 acres SW¼ SE¼  
Section 29  
36.0 acres NW¼ NE¼  
22.0 acres SW¼ NE¼  
38.0 acres NE¼ NW¼  
Section 32  
T. 17 S., R. 47 E., W. M.

An order of the Water Resources Director entered November 10, 1977, Volume 30, Page 22, canceled 3.0 acres of the water right described in certificate of water right recorded at Page 7046, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates. This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 20, 1977 and supersedes certificate 7046.


The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

\*if available at the original point of diversion; SE¼ NE¼, Section 2, T. 18 S., R. 46 E., W. M., Brosnan Ditch-170 feet North and 160 feet West from the E¼ Corner, Section 2

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
