## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** MABLE HUTCHINSON

of Union, State of Oregon, 97883, has  
a right to the use of the waters of Catherine Creek

a tributary of Grande Ronde River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 220.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at page 1; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1884

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three acre feet per  
acre in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth  
of a cubic foot per second per acre; if available at the original point of  
diversion; Godley Ditch No. 2.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 27, T. 3 S., R. 39 E., W. M.,  
3850 feet South and 1000 feet East from the NW Corner, Section 27; SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ,  
Section 3, T. 4 S., R. 39 E., W. M., Godley Ditch No. 2-1188 feet North and 2448  
feet East from the SW Corner, Section 3  
A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

40.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
20.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
40.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
40.0 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
40.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
40.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved  
by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 23, 1964 and supersedes  
certificate of water right recorded on Page 6392, Volume 6, State Record of Water  
Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the  
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
