The point of diversion is located in the SW_4 NW_4 , Section 6, T. 2 S., R. 13 E., W. M., 280 feet North and 20 feet East, 780 feet North and 800 feet East, both from the W_4 Corner, Section 6.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.5 acres SW4 NW4 2.5 acres NW4 SW4 Section 6 T. 2 S., R. 13 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered July 7, 1969 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at Page 5637, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
