CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GEO. P. DYKE

of Baker, State of Oregon, has
a right to the use of the waters of Powder River

a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of
irrigation of 85.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Baker County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at page 291; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from May 6, 1891

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40th of one cubic
foot per second per acre;

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, T. 10 S., R. 40 E., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

5.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
40.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
40.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

T. 10 S., R. 40 E., W. M.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior
certificate recorded at page 4118, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certifi-
cates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director
entered on June 8, 1979, approving transfer application No. 3023.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
