CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EDWARD HINES LUMBER COMPANY
GRANT COUNTY DIVISION

of P.O. Box 227, John Day, State of Oregon, 97845, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Sump No. 1, Well No. 2, Well No. 3 and Sump No. 4

a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of industrial use: fire protection, boiler use, general mill uses, and log sprinkling

under Permit No. G-7819 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 29, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.92 cubic feet per second, being 0.22 c.f.s. from Sump No. 1 for fire protection, 1.0 c.f.s. from Well No. 2 for boiler use, 1.0 c.f.s. from Well No. 3 for general mill uses, and 0.7 c.f.s. from Sump No. 4 for log sprinkling

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.

The well is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, T. 13 S., R. 31 E., W. M., No. 1-180 feet South and 834 feet East; No. 2-423 feet South and 870 feet East; No. 3-610 feet South and 650 feet East; No. 4-1200 feet South and 50 feet East, all from the W $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 22

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~of one cubic foot per second per acre,~~ appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
