## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** EDWARD HINES LUMBER COMPANY

Grant County Division  
of P.O. Box 227, John Day, State of Oregon, 97845, has made  
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of  
sump

a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of  
log sprinkling

under Permit No. G-7820 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in  
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from  
June 29, 1977  
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
1.6 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well.  
The well is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 21, T. 13 S., R. 31 E., W. M., 50 feet  
South and 600 feet West from the E $\frac{1}{2}$  Corner, Section 21

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to-----of one cubic foot per second  
~~per acre~~, appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or  
substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right
