of Central Point , State of Oregon, 97501 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigation of 125.88 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 2282 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 30, 1914

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.573 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW_4 SW $_4$, Section 15, T. 36 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 920 feet East from the W_4 Corner, Section 15

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 3896, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 28, 1979, approving transfer application No. 4190 and NOT canceled by the provisions of orders of the Water Resources Director entered May 13, 1969 and October 5, 1977.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
