CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

IRMA L. CALKINS

of 11619 S.W. King George Dr., No. 2, TigardState of Oregon, 97223 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed creek and reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1145 and Willamette River

a tributary of Columbia River irrigation of 215.2 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 20223 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 28, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.69 cubic feet per second, being 0.40 c.f.s. from stream and reservoir and 2.29 c.f.s. from Willamette River

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 5 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 6, T. 4 S., R. 2 W., W. M., Reservoir-340 feet North and 1000 feet West from the SE Corner, Lot 5 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 6; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 12, T. 4 S., R. 3 W., W. M., river-160 feet North and 3250 feet West from the SW Corner, Lot 4 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 7

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1145.

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

An order of the Water Resources Director entered July 22, 1968 canceled the right for the irrigation of 30.1 acres from the unnamed creek and reservoir. This certificate is issued to describe that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 22416, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the order and to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 30, 1968 and supersedes certificate 22416.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
