CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That AMANDA A. CHENOWETH

of Enterprise, State of Oregon, 97828, has a right to the use of the waters of Alder Creek

a tributary of Wallowa River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 153.5

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 5, at page 154; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1889

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1 acre foot per acre during any period of 30 days prior to July 31st of each year, and thereafter not to exceed 1 acre foot per acre during the entire remainder of the irrigation season;

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

36.5 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 15

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 2977, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 19, 1939, approving transfer application No. C-20.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
