## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JOHN ESPINOLA

of Rt. 4, Box 615, Roseburg , State of Oregon, 97470 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Tenmile Creek

a tributary of Olalla Creek irrigation of 53.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 37540 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 26, 1973

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.67 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE4 SE4, as projected within Ollivant DLC 51, Section 28, T. 28 S., R. 7 W., W. M., 850 feet North and 840 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 28

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

16.9 acres NE¼ SE¼
26.0 acres NW¼ SE¼
9.5 acres SW½ SE¼
0.1 acre SE½ SE¼
All as projected within Ollivant DLC 51
0.9 acre SW½ SE¼
As projected within J. Olmstead DLC 53
Section 28
T. 28 S., R. 7 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
