or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $_4$  NE $_4$ , Section 4, T. 3 S., R. 9 E., W. M., 2730 feet North and 1000 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 4

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,
