under Permit No. 28580 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

January 3, 1963 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 8.0 gallons per minute, being 1 g.p.m. from Fenced Spring and 4 g.p.m. from Pipeline Spring for stor', and 3 g.p.m. from Fenced Spring for public campground

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 SE4, Section 20, T. 34 S., R. 14 E., W. M., Pipeline Spring-1020 feet North and 710 feet East; Fenced Spring-820 feet North and 610 feet East, both from the S4 Corner, Section 20

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ------of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW₄ SE₄ Section 20 T. 34 S., R. 14 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
